Dear customer,

A64 Old Malton Junction – safety improvement

A-one+ working on behalf of National Highways (formally Highways England) will be carrying out safety improvement work on the A64 at the Old Malton junction.

What are we doing?

We'll be realigning east and westbound exit slip roads utilising the verge to improve the entries into the circulatory carriageway. We are also carrying out minor realignments of the A169 and B1257 splitter islands and updating the signage to reflect these safety improvements.

In addition, we're adding lane markings to the roundabout, and making improvements to the footways around the eastbound exit slip road

What's happening and when?

We plan to start work on Monday 22 November 2021 and expect to finish work by early March 2022.

Closures, restrictions, and diversions

To carry out the work safely and to maintain access for customers, most of the work will be carried out during the day using lane closures that will remain in place 24/7. This will allow our staff to safely carry out the work. In addition, a reduced speed limit will be in place.

To complete the realignment of the two A64 slip roads we will need to close each road fully for about a week but not at the same time. We will place signs showing the dates of these closures around the area, once they have been agreed with our contractors.

Signed diversion routes will be in place which have been agreed in advance with the police and local authority.

- Westbound exit diversion route - traffic will be diverted off the A64 at the Brambling Fields junction and along the B1248 Scarborough Road to the B1257 Old Malton Road / Town Street to the roundabout.
- Eastbound exit diversion route - traffic will be diverted further along the A64 to the junction at Brambling Fields where they will then be directed westwards on the A64 to the roundabout

Near the end of the work, we will also close half the roundabout at a time overnight between 8pm and 6am, to apply the new surfacing and white lines.

Extra information

Where nightwork is necessary, we'll try to finish the noisiest work before 11pm to minimise noise disruption as much as we can. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience.
